Adult Caregiver support group meets this Thursday, March 10th at 6:30pm.

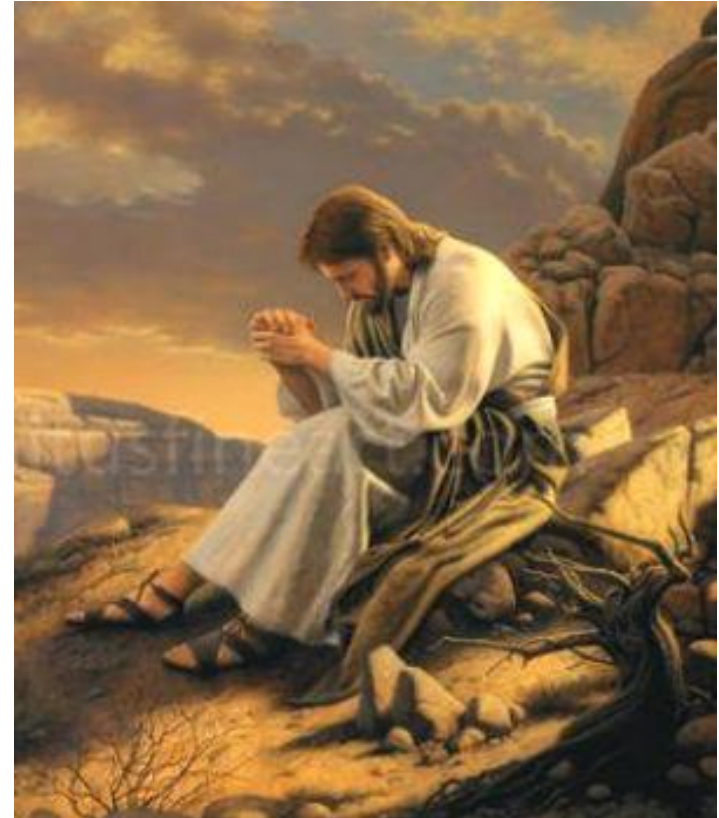
